

**Epupa and Ovahimba Experience - (4 day safari in the Kaokoland)**

*This 4 day Namibia safari gives you the chance to follow the mighty Kunene River, visit the fort town of Sesfontein, the Epupa Falls, and a number of Ovahimba settlements in the Kaokoland. You depart from Palmwag Lodge and make your way to the Epupa Falls via Sesfontein, visiting a number of Ovahimba Settlements en route. Enjoy overnight camping on the banks of the magical waterfalls and day time walks to explore the surroundings. Return to Palmwag Lodge on day four via Fort Sesfontein.*

*Game viewing is excellent throughout.*

**Itinerary Details**

**Day 1: Depart Palmwag Lodge for Epupa Falls**

Depart in the morning from Palmwag Lodge and drive over the Jouberts pass near Sesfontein to the village of Opuwo. Drive on via Okangwati and meet the first nomadic Ovahimbas and their herds of cattle en route. Onwards to the Epupa Falls - a

true natural paradise surrounded by stunning mountain ranges, densely overgrown river banks and clusters of Makalani palm trees providing the necessary shade for our camp site on the banks of the river. You are free to explore the waterfalls and enjoy an unforgettable sundowner on one of the viewing points on top of the Falls. Camping overnight.

### **Day 2: Overnight Epupa**

After breakfast enjoy a short walk along the waterfall. There are visits to various Ovahimba villages and settlements on the morning drive into the Baynes Mountains. Return to Epupa campsite for a second night camping.

### **Day 3: Enyandi**

Break up camp in the morning. From here the journey follows the course of the river towards the village of Enyandi where you can visit one of the agricultural gardens of the Ovahimbabas. The trail continues deep into the valleys and mountains of this picturesque central part of the Kaokoland. Camp is set up under huge age old acacia trees in a dry riverbed, and within the vicinity of an Ovahimba Village. Enjoy a sundowner, for it's your last night camping under the Namibian sky.
