

Victoria Falls and Chobe National Park

This six day itinerary takes in the magnificent Victoria Falls where you can choose to be as adventurous as you wish! Followed by a stay in Chobe National Park where viewing the wide variety of wildlife and birdlife can be enjoyed either from a vehicle or by boat on the river.

This short safari can be taken as a stand-alone trip or added to a longer itinerary. There are also many different hotels available to choose from in Victoria Falls... ask our advice.

Day by Day Itinerary

Day one

On arrival at Livingstone Airport you will be met and transferred to the Zambezi Sun Hotel where you will stay for two nights (B).



Zambezi Sun

The Zambezi Sun is located on the edge of the eastern cataract of the Victoria Falls and is an unpretentious, fun and welcoming hotel. With its warm, earthy architecture, inspired by an African walled village, bright mosaics and fabrics as well as Zambian artworks, the Zambezi Sun will provide a memorable stay.

The en-suite guestrooms are open and airy and acknowledge their African roots in the red earth colour of the rounded walls, tastefully decorated with handcrafted Zambian designs. All the rooms spill out to the African bush or face the landscaped pool with private, shaded balconies offering guests a perfect place to relax.

Day two

Choose from a wide range of activities which are available to visitors. Maybe experience the Zambezi River on a jet boat or relax on a catamaran sunset cruise. Elephant back rides or river safaris are also available. For the more adventurous, why not try white water rafting or bungee jumping! For wildlife lovers try a river safari for aquatic and fabulous birdlife or perhaps an opportunity to your luck fly fishing?



Day three

Depart the Zambezi Sun Hotel and transfer by road and boat to Muchenje Lodge, in Chobe National Park for the following three nights (FB). The lodge is only two hours from Livingstone/Victoria Falls.

Muchenje Lodge

Muchenje Lodge is situated within 'The last Eden of Chobe' and offers an excellent safari experience for guests. Situated on the western side of Chobe National Park, Muchenje is the only lodge in this area and offers unique and prolific game viewing experiences. Famous for its elephant and buffalo herds, Chobe is also home to numerous lions, as well as a great diversity of plains game and bird species.

The lodge is on an escarpment overlooking the banks of the Chobe River and has stunning views across the flood plain. The elegant main lodge incorporates a dining area, bar and viewing platform, while the swimming pool offers fantastic views and provides a relaxing setting for guests. Each of the 11 en-suite rooms is beautifully furnished with an African ambience.



Days four and five

Chobe plays host to some of the world's best game viewing and Muchenje is perfectly located for seeing the best that Chobe has to offer. The park is famous for its large herds of elephant and buffalo, along with numerous predators - including lions, leopards and wild dogs. There is a great diversity of plains game and an astonishing array of bird species.



Game drives are the key activity - in an open 4x4 with professional guides, available early morning and afternoon – or all day! Game viewing can also be by boat on the Chobe River; on foot during bush walks; or by night on spot lit drives after dinner. Cultural visits to the local villages can also be arranged.

Day six

After breakfast you will depart the lodge and transfer by road and boat to Livingstone airport.

The cost of this itinerary is from £935 per person, based on twin share.
