Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1 – Johannesburg – Kruger National Park

You leave your Johannesburg hotel at 8 am on a comfortable 5-hour journey to the Mpumalanga province passing through the towns of Nelspruit, White River and Hazyview. This journey takes you through incredible scenery – mountains, panoramic passes, valleys, rivers, waterfalls and forests characterise the landscape. You will arrive at your hotel in the late afternoon and check in.

With great excitement, you enter the world-famous Kruger National Park for an afternoon of game-viewing. Return to your safari hotel in the town of Hazyview and delight in a sumptuous dinner in lush surrounds.

All safaris in the Kruger National Park are operated in specially designed open safari vehicles and accompanied by a qualified and experienced FGASA and SATOUR registered guide.

Kruger National Park consists of nearly 2 million hectares of unrivalled diversity of life forms fused with historical and archaeological sites – this is real Africa. The world-renowned Kruger National Park offers a wildlife experience that ranks with the best in Africa. Established in 1898 to protect the wildlife of the South African Lowveld, the park is a world leader in advanced environmental management techniques and policies. Truly the flagship of the South African national parks, Kruger is home to an impressive number of species: 336 trees, 49 fish, 34 amphibians, 114 reptiles, 507 birds and 147 mammals.



Day 2 – Kruger National Park

As is the custom on safari, you will wake with the dawn and enjoy an early breakfast so that you can travel into the Kruger in the cool morning, during which the wildlife is wonderfully active.



Your expert guide will be on the lookout to show you the Big 5 – lion, elephant, leopard, buffalo and rhino, as well as the many other animals and birds.

Enjoy lunch (for guest's own account) at a shady rest camp before setting back out to see all that you can see before returning to your safari hotel for a relaxing dinner.

Your guide will cover as much ground as possible. Stops will be included at the various lookout points within the park.

Day 3 – Johannesburg

You have the morning at leisure before setting off to the charming town of Graskop for lunch (for guest's own account).

The route back to Johannesburg offers you the opportunity to see more of Mpumalanga's gorgeous scenery and interesting towns. Travelling through Kowyn's Pass you come to the quaint historic town of Pilgrim's Rest, where many of the original miners' houses are preserved. You also travel through Lydenburg, Dullstroom and Belfast, before arriving in the 'City of Gold' at about 18h30.

Due to the early start and late return it is recommended that you stay in Johannesburg before and after the tour.
