Mt Kenya Climb Routes and Rates

Camping/Huts - Costs are given below for private camping (2 person tents; single tents will incur a supplement). Shared huts on Mt Kenya are also an option and marginally cheaper – please enquire for rates.

Seasons - Rates are based on high season (July-March). Low season (Apr-Jun) rates are again marginally lower.
