

Jabali Ridge, Ruaha

Luxury family safari to southern Tanzania available during February half-term



18 Feb: Arrive Dar es Salaam; Fly to Ruaha (Jabali Ridge Camp)

Arrive Dar es Salaam early morning on the overnight flight from London. You will be met by your driver on clearing customs and transferred to the nearby domestic airport for your flight to Ruaha, departing late morning (10:30 / 13:30).


Your safari guide and driver will waiting at the Ruaha airstrip to greet you with a picnic lunch, so that you may start your safari as soon as you land.

Ruaha is the second largest game park in Tanzania, and offers a game-viewing experience equal to its size. It has one of the largest populations of elephant in any park in Africa and the dry open hillsides also encourage antelope, giraffe and buffalo to gather in large herds. The terrain, and relatively sparse vegetation, is particularly good for sighting predators, including lion, occasionally leopard, and very occasionally African wild dog.

After enjoying a short afternoon drive in Ruaha, continue to Jabali Ridge Camp, your home for the next 6 nights (fully inclusive, including safari activities).

Jabali Ridge Camp

Opened in September 2017, Jabali Ridge already stands out as one of Ruaha's most luxurious camps, providing a standard of accommodation not otherwise found in this remote and often-overlooked Tanzanian safari park.

Jabali accommodates its guests in 8 luxury suites, hidden amid granite boulders on a high rocky ridge in the north-eastern Ruaha. From this secluded location, it provides easy access to the prime game-viewing areas around the Mwagusi River (the focus of game drives at the lodge), while also serving as an ideal base for walking safaris on the comparatively quieter eastern perimeter of the park.

Jabali's guest suites are wonderfully spacious. Fully open at the sides (with louvre shutters to seal the rooms at night), each opens onto a wide verandah with seating area and hammock – and splendid views! All rooms are furnished with king-size beds and feature ample hanging space.









Jabali Lodge's standout feature is its infinity pool. Positioned on the edge of the ridge, it offers stunning views of the surrounding baobab-strewn plains. Separate to the pool is a lounge and dining area, which, like the rooms, it fully open at the sides. There is also a spa.



19-23 Feb: Ruaha National Park (Jabali Ridge Camp)

The next 5 days are free for you to explore Ruaha National Park at your own pace.

Ruaha is the second largest game park in Tanzania, and offers a game-viewing experience equal to its size. It has one of the largest populations of elephant in any park in Africa and the dry open hillsides also encourage antelope, giraffe and buffalo to gather into large herds. The terrain is particularly good for sighting predators, including lion, occasionally leopard, and very occasionally African wild dog.

Activities available at Jabali Ridge Lodge include morning and afternoon game drives (focused on the Mwagusi River area), as well as night drives and walking safaris in the eastern Ruaha.









Full-day game drives with picnic lunch and bush breakfasts can also be arranged.

24 Feb: Departure

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast before transferring to the airstrip for the late morning flight to Dar es Salaam (11:45 / 13:50), where you connect with your international flight home.
