Zambia Photography Course



Join accomplished photographer David Rogers, for a photographic workshop you will never forget. David is a well-known wildlife photographer and author of several books, including Zambia Safari in Style. David will lead the safari and as a leading photographer will accompany you on all game drives, give advice, analyse results, and also look at how best to use Adobe Lightroom. In addition to wildlife, you will also look at landscapes, macro work, birds, insects, and people.

This is a unique opportunity to benefit from the knowledge of a leading wildlife photographer and see the South Luangwa at its most colourful. Bring your own digital camera and computer for downloading the photographs.

Day by day Itinerary

5th November: Lusaka – Mfuwe, South Luangwa Valley

Take the domestic flight from Lusaka to Mfuwe. You will be met on arrival at Mfuwe International Airport your guide and driver for the one hour drive to Nkwali Camp, where you check in for three nights.

Situated on private land, Nkwali Camp's six thatch-and-bamboo chalets – each with open-air bathroom and private sitting areas – all enjoy a wide view of the Luangwa River and, beyond it, South Luangwa National Park. Nkwali is ideally situated for exploring the region.

David Rogers will join you in camp this evening and provide an overview of what to expect in the days to come.

6th & 7th November: Nkwali Camp

Each day starts at dawn with breakfast served around the campfire, the porridge heated on the fire and the toast cooked by the coals. The early start is to ensure you enter the park in time for

the fantastic dawn light – luckily the camp has direct access to the park so it often takes only a few swift minutes.

The morning will be spent photographing different subjects, from the very small to the very big, before returning to camp for lunch.

After enjoying a delicious lunch, you can choose to enjoy a midday siesta or sort through your photographs and practice with Adobe Lightroom.



After tea and cakes you head back into the park in the late afternoon/dusk to find more subjects to photograph, returning to camp for dinner around half eight.

Most evenings there will be a slideshow illustrating some of the points taught throughout the day, and you'll also have a chance to show off your best shots.

8th November: Nsefu Camp

Following a relaxed breakfast you will head out of camp on foot with your guide and trek towards Nsefu Camp, stopping for tea and cake along the way and arriving in time for lunch.

Check into Nsefu Camp for three nights.

Nsefu Camp is situated on a sweeping bend of the Luangwa River. Zambia's original game camp, it dates back to the early fifties, when the Nsefu Sector was first recognised, and is one of only two Robin Pope camps in this sector of the Park.

Nsefu accommodates it guests in six rondavels, each with a direct view of the river and private verandah.



On arrival you will be shown to your rondavel and then lunch will be served followed by a welldeserved siesta before the afternoon and evening game drive.








9th & 10th November: Nsefu Camp

Your last nights will be spent discovering the unique region of the park within which Nsefu is located.

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Mfuwe Airport for your flight to Lusaka.
